Clay County Recreation Park (Campground) has immediate openings for Camp Host(s) for Clay County Recreation Park Campground and Gibson Cove Campground.

Both of these parks are located in the southwestern mountains North Carolina on beautiful Lake Chatuge in Hayesville, North Carolina. The campgrounds are on Myers Chapel Road, which connects with Hwy 69 and Hwy 64. The park offers camping & RV facilities, hiking trails, playground equipment, a beach area and easy access to Lake Chatuge for boating, fishing and swimming.

This is a volunteer opportunity.

In exchange for helping around the park, successful candidates will be provided with a rent-free RV site with power, water, and garbage services. County to provide sewage pumping service at no cost to the Camp Host.

Job Duties

The successful candidate will be responsible for checking in campers, assisting with the reservation system, cleaning the bathrooms, and other light landscaping duties around the park.

Qualifications

Applicants must pass a background check and be at least 18 years of age. The applicant must be outgoing, courteous, and helpful to all park visitors. The applicant must provide their own functional recreational vehicle for living accommodations. Tents are not allowed by the campground host.
